Guidelines

Purpose

The purpose of Inuit Elders support fund is to provide short-term financial support to Kivalliq Inuit Elders over the age of 60 during the COVID-19 pandemic. The Inuit Elders Support Fund is part of the Kivalliq Inuit Association's COVID-19 Emergency Relief Fund with support from the Indigenous Community Support Fund of the Government of Canada.

Eligibility

ALL Kivalliq Inuit Elders 60 years of age and older are eligible for a monthly cheque for \$500 from April through June. KIA aims to process payments in the middle of each month.

THERE IS NO NEED TO APPLY, KIA will issue a first payment of \$500 to every eligible Kivalliq Inuit Elder on the NTI Enrolment list in April.

Elders will be required to provide their Social Insurance Number to receive the May/June benefits.

Please note ALL financial contributions made to individual Inuit may be subject to personal income tax

How to access the Inuit Elders Support Fund

Eligible Kivalliq Inuit Elders will receive a cheque for \$500 in April, by mail or distributed by Community Liaison Officers in each community.

Elders will be required to provide their Social Insurance Number to receive the May/June benefits.
