



# Achievement Award Guidelines

## 1. Program Overview

The Kivalliq Inuit Association Achievement Award supports Kivalliq NTI Beneficiaries who have completed post-secondary education since 2019. Awards are available for each level of education completed – certificate, diploma, degree, master’s and Ph.D.

## 2. Eligibility Criteria

- Must be enrolled as an NTI Beneficiary under Kivalliq
- Must have completed post-secondary studies from 2019 to present
- Can apply once per level of education
- Must provide proof of graduation and transcripts

## 3. Award Amounts

Education Level	Amount	Notes
Certificate	\$500	One-time award
Diploma	\$1,000	If certificate already received, remaining \$500 will be awarded
Degree	\$2,000	Up to \$2,000 total; adjusted if diploma already received
Master’s	\$2,500	Up to \$2,500 total
Ph.D	\$3,500	Up to \$3,500 total

## 4. Example: Undergraduate Degree Awards

Students completing an **undergraduate degree** (e.g., B.A., B.Sc., B.S.W) can apply for:

- Up to a **maximum of \$2,000**
- If they previously received a **diploma award (\$1,000)**, they can still receive **\$1,000** for the degree to total \$2,000

**Example:** You completed a 4-year Bachelor of Social Work; You previously received \$1,000 for your diploma; You’ll receive **\$1,000** to reach the **\$2,000 maximum**

## 5. Appeals

If you disagree with a decision, you may appeal within 30 days of receiving the result. All decisions are final.

## 6. Right of KIA

KIA reserves the right to adjust award amounts or program terms based on funding availability.
